



Making Australian Schools Safer:

The National Safe Schools Framework, developed by the Commonwealth Department of Education, Science and Training, represents a social vision of how Australian schools can be when student safety becomes a priority.



The summary report provides an analysis of the projects of 171 schools and identifies significant recurring issues and themes that emerged.

These themes include:

- Planning for sustainability
- Adapting programs for special student cohorts
- Teaching social skills and resilience skills
- Enhancing positive relationships
- Taking a whole school approach
- Creating caring, respectful pro-social and supportive school cultures
- The adoption of a data-driven and evidence based approach.
